

How to Enrol Mac to Intune

Enrolling a Mac computer in Microsoft Intune allows you to manage and secure the device as part of your organization's mobile device management (MDM) strategy. To enrol a Mac in Intune, you'll need administrative access to your Intune console and the Mac you want to enrol. Here are the general steps to enrol a Mac in Intune:

1. Prerequisites:

- a. Ensure you have an active Microsoft Intune subscription.
- b. Make sure you have an Apple ID and password for the Mac you want to enrol.
- c. The Mac should be running macOS 10.11 or later.

2. Access the Intune Portal:

- a. Sign into the Azure portal (<https://portal.azure.com>) with your Microsoft Intune administrator account.

3. Add the Mac as a Device:

- b. Install the Company Portal app on the Mac.

6. Launch the Company Portal App:

- a. Open the Company Portal app on the Mac.

7. Sign In:

- a. Sign into the Company Portal app using your Apple ID and password. This should be the same Apple ID associated with the Mac.

8. Enrolment:

- a. The Company Portal app will guide you through the enrolment process.
- b. You may need to grant permissions and install a management profile on the Mac.



9. Complete Enrolment:

- a. Follow the on-screen prompts to complete the enrolment process.
- b. The Mac will be registered with Intune and can now be managed from the Intune console.

10. Verify Enrolment:

- a. Return to the Azure portal, navigate to "Devices" or "All devices," and you should see the enrolled Mac listed there.

11. Configure Policies and Settings:

- a. Once the Mac is enrolled, you can configure policies, apps, and settings for the device through the Intune portal.

12. Monitor and Manage:

- a. Continuously monitor and manage the enrolled Mac through the Intune portal to ensure it complies with your organization's security and compliance policies.
